To the registrar of County of Senneboune
Sir,

I do hereby notify you as follows, to wit:
that Mistress Anne Stuart widow of the late
Archibald Mc Donald, in his lifetime of the
Parish of St. Sophie, departed this life &
died on the nineteenth day of the month
of June last one thousand eight hundred
and sixty six -

And that before her said demise she
had by her last will & testament received
before Mr. E. Lemire & his colleagues
two witnesses on the thirty first day
of May last one thousand eight hundred
& sixty six, brought for registration along
with these presents, willed & bequeathed
to me in full property all her moveables
& immoveables.

And that the immoveables so bequeathed
to me are described as follows to wit:
a tract or parcel of land lying or situate in the
second rang of Ste. Paisly, in the parish of St.
Sophie, known as the north half of lot number
fifteen, containing three acres in width by fifteen
acres in depth, the whole more or less, bound-
ed in front by the public road, in rear by the
lands of the third concession, on one side by lot
number fourteen belonging to Edouard Langlois
and on the other side by lot number sixteen
belonging to myself; without any building
thereon erected -

ber one thousand eight hundred and sixty six -
